KC AND THE SUNSHINE BAND TO PERFORM AT A NIGHT IN THE BALLPARK

Grammy-award winning funk group to perform April 8

Scottsdale, Ariz. – Grammy-award winning music group, KC and the Sunshine Band, will perform with special guest Boogie Knights at A Night at the Ballpark at Tempe Diablo Stadium on Saturday, April 8. Tickets are on sale now and are available at go.ordermytix.com/event/ballpark. The concert serves as a fundraiser for the Tempe Diablos and Mesa HoHoKams with proceeds benefitting both organizations. Doors open at 7 p.m.

KC and the Sunshine Band is a disco funk music group that formed in Florida in 1973. The band is best known for their hit songs “That’s the Way (I Like It),” “(Shake, Shake, Shake) Shake Your Booty,” and “I’m Your Boogie Man,” among others. The group’s self-titled second album was released in 1975, went triple platinum and yielded their first U.S. hit, “Get Down Tonight.” In 1979, the group took home a Grammy for Album of the Year with “Saturday Night Fever.” The band’s frontman, Harry Casey, has had his music featured at the Super Bowl, World Series, conference championships and other major sporting events.

“We’re combining our passions for our communities and exceptional live entertainment to host an event that will help us continue to serve and better our city,” said Tempe Diablos Event Chairman Ryan Thompson. “We’re looking forward to sharing an evening of music and fun with our friends and families while supporting a worthy cause.”
